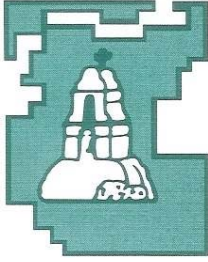

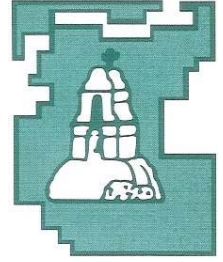

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1. Vendor applications must be submitted by **July 15, 2008** to ensure a reserved space. Please contact us as soon as possible if you are unable to meet this deadline.
2. The vendor space fee of **\$300** must accompany your application. Checks/cashier's checks/money orders must be made out to Pala Band of Mission Indians, with "powwow" specified in the Notes field.
3. Vendors will receive confirmation by mail after June 15, 2008.
4. Vendor space locations will be assigned.
5. Vendor spaces are 10 feet by 10 feet. Vendors may not extend their space. Double space is double the price.
6. Vendors are required to donate a raffle item of \$50 value.
7. Vendors must provide their own canopies, tables, chairs, lighting, and power source. **GENERATORS MUST BE PLACED ON PLYWOOD – NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. Set-up time is from 7:00 am to 9:00 am on Friday, August 1. **ALL VEHICLES MUST LEAVE THE POWWOW AREA BY 9:00 AM.**
9. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean.
10. The Pala Band of Mission Indians reserves the right to prohibit vendors from selling or displaying any items which are disturbing to the attending community at the powwow. No selling of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, cigarette lighters, or weapons of any kind will be allowed. No fart bombs, stink bombs, or crazy/silly string allowed. Endangered animals/animal parts are strictly prohibited.
11. Failure to comply with these regulations will result in immediate suspension of vending privileges with no refund of fees, and exclusion from future powwows.
12. Overnight camping is available.
13. The Pala Band of Mission Indians is not responsible for vandalism or theft or damages to vendor items that are left unattended or left out over night.
14. The Pala Band of Mission Indians is not responsible for any injury, theft, damage, or expense incurred by vendors.
