The University of California San Diego (UCSD) in partnership with community organizations, health care centers, and apprenticeship placement partners are leading a Community Health Worker (CHW) training program to develop capacity in Native American communities and in Immigrant/refugee organizations.

The basic CHW training program:

- 1. Hybrid training- both online and in-person options will be available.
- 2. Selection and interview of eligible candidates
- 3. Initial 30 hours of CHW training
